

DOORS OPEN DAY AT SEILI Thu 16.7.2015

Welcome to Seili to get to know about research on the archipelago and the Archipelago research Institute of the University of Turku on Thursday 16.7.2015 at 9 – 17.

Guided tours from the ferry pier in Finnish at 9.00, 11.00, 12.50 and 14.40 and in Swedish at 12.50.

The research boat Aurelia and the Museum Church of Seili are open all day.

Two lectures in Finnish will be held at the Institute's lecture hall at 13.30. The first lecture, held by development manager *Markus Merenmies* (the National Archives of Finland), is on applying geographic information system (GIS) in the analysis of historical materials. The topic is "*Information about location and geographical information: analysis of historical material from the new perspective*" (45 min). This will be completed by lecture of the president *Anne Wilenius* (the Pro Seili – Heritage Society) with the topic of "*Seili in ancient documents and maps*" (15 min).

Other research projects of at the Institute are to be seen at a poster exhibition in the main building. There is also a Baltic Sea aquarium at the Institution.

At the inner court of the Institution the Pro Seili–Heritage Society tells about their activities and sells coffee and pastries. There is a larger assortment of the Societies souvenirs and refreshments (i.e. soft drinks and Seili-liquorice) at the Summer Kiosk next to the Church pier.

Visitors reach Seili by the connection ferry Östern (6€ or 3 €/person).
