4. Purpose and the legal basis for the processing of personal data

ChemSAR project is operating 2016-2019. The project creates standard operational procedures for maritime search and rescue operations in HNS incidents. The purpose of processing of personal data is to ensure interaction and collaboration with partners and shareholders, and to disseminate information about the results of the project during the project lifetime and during appropriate time after the project's ending. The data is used for research, informing and communicating with the shareholders.

The legal basis for processing data is based on the data controller's legitimate interest. The persons are on the register based on their work position or other position relevant to the project.

6. Sources of personal data

The data has been collected from public sources or the persons have given the information themselves.

7. Information on transferring data to third parties in and outside EU or the European economic region.

Data will not be transferred.

8. Principles for the protection of personal data

The registered data is stored according to the best practices, good information security and legislative regulations so that it is protected from external parties. The register is protected with user identification and passwords as well as structural and group-specific authorisation. Registers containing personal data can be accessed only by members of ChemSAR project personnel who require the use of personal data for performing their work tasks. The system can be accessed only through a protected network connection.

9. The period for retaining personal data

The data will be erased when the legal basis for processing data no longer exists, or when a person has asked for removal of information.

10. Rights of the data subject

The data subject has the right to access their personal data retained by the data controller, the right to rectification or erasure of data, and the right to restrict or object the processing of data, and the right to transfer the data from one controller to another.

The data subject has the right to make a complaint with the supervisory authority.
