	In addition, the registration information can be used for event invitations, newsletter distribution, contact dealings, reporting, and other information sharing and enabling collaboration after the event. The legal basis of processing the data for these purposes is Article 6(1)(f) of the General Data Protection Regulation, legitimate interest of the joint controllers. Such legitimate interest exists because a relevant and appropriate relationship between an event participant and the joint controllers arises from the registration for an event, and this relationship is comparable to a customer relationship.
	Data related to accessibility needs, allergens and dietary restrictions can be processed for delivering individual services to a participant if a participant has given explicit consent to processing such data (Article 9(2)(a) of the General Data Protection Regulation).
