- Call for applications (study right)

• Doctoral candidates' annual progress reporting: any additional information requested by the doctoral programme must be submitted by mid-April at the latest.

May

• Doctoral candidates' annual progress reporting: the doctoral programme makes a decision and informs those doctoral candidates whose study right will be transferred to the passive register on 31 July.

August

• Orientation of new doctoral candidates (study right begins on 1 August)

September

• Call for applications (study right and funded positions)

November

• Decisions on study rights and funded positions
