Student understands the basics of the systematic reviews and meta-analysis: how to search, evaluate and qualify the systematic review or meta-analysis material/articles, how to pool the studies, understand different kind of meta-analyses and know how to handle the publication bias.

Study methods: Lectures (6 hours) and workshops (4 hours) and reporting work (2-4 pages based on workshops and your own study question).

Requirements: Active participation in the lectures and workshops (1 ECTS) and sending the reporting work after the course (1 ECTS).
