Curious about merging health and technology, and creating innovative devices for the healthcare sector?

This 10-week short course, with 20 hours of contact teaching, provides an introduction to health device development.

Participants will gain valuable insights into the different stages of the health device development process, while being provided with a unique platform for innovative thinking in an international and transdisciplinary environment.

Study methods

The course is delivered online and consists of synchronous and asynchronous learning sessions. Synchronous learning sessions are organized in Zoom.

Moodle is used as a course platform for all course communication and delivering materials.

Passing the course requires attendance to lectures and successful completion of learning assignments. Course language is English.

Target groups

The course is open for all Moi University, University of the Western Cape and University of Turku master level students in the fields of health, biomedicine, medicine and technology. The course is limited to 45 students. 15 places will be reserved for each collaborating university.

The course will be held in autumn 2026, from 24th September to 3rd December.
