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

Credits

- Fail = no ECTS-credits
 - Failed courses are not listed in the transcript of records
- Return the course work by the given deadlines (Note: your study right expires at the end of the semester, 31.7.2024)

- <u>Note:</u> If the grading scale used is pass/ fail, it is not possible to get a numeric grade for the course
 - Grading scale is the same for all students and cannot be changed by request
 - A pass is simply a pass, it does not equal to any numeric grade
- Assessment is not based on normal (Gaussian) distribution
- Transcript of Records and results:

Essays

- Essays are individual work and they should not be copied from other students or from the Internet.
- Essays must always have references to works consulted and/or quoted, with a bibliography at the end.
- All forms of plagiarism, e.g. copying from the sources without proper reference indication, is regarded as falsification, which is taken very seriously and will at least lead to failing the course.

Rules on student attendance (1):

- Attendance at seminars, small groups, tutorials, demonstrations, school visits, and individual guidance is compulsory unless told otherwise.
- No substitutive assignment is required if a student is absent from compulsory teaching for 10 % at the most.
- A substitutive assignment is required if a student is absent from compulsory teaching for 10 – 50 %.
- No possibility for a substitutive assignment if a student is absent for more than 50 % of the compulsory teaching. A student has to attend the course again.



Rules on student attendance (2):

- Teachers informs at the beginning of the course if there is a possibility for substitutive assignment or not. Teachers are not obliged to provide this possibility.
- It is however desired that a substitutive assignment would be set in the cases where the student's absence doesn't depend on him/her or is due to compelling reasons.
- \rightarrow Holiday trip or working is not considered to be such a case.

- It is possible to make changes to the Learning Agreement
