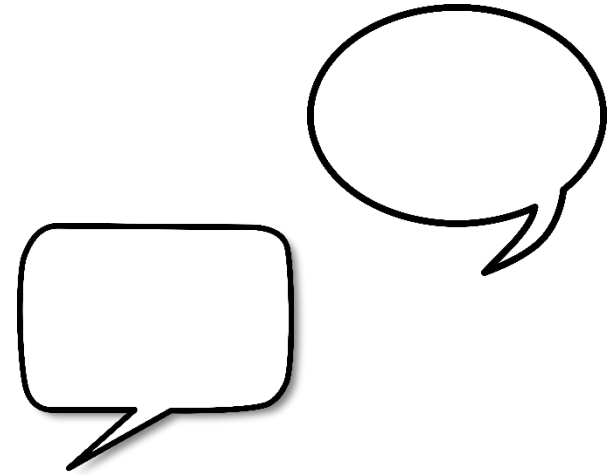

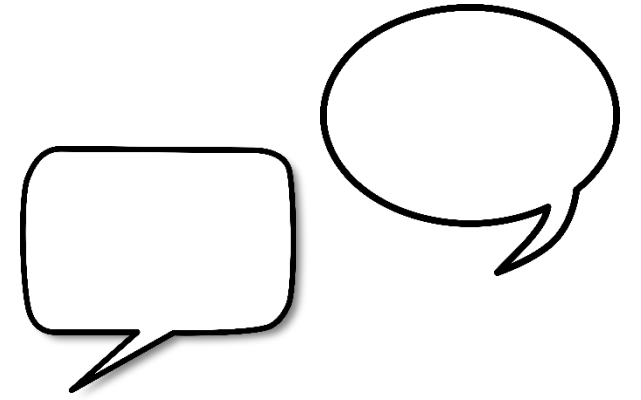

Teaching remotely in Zoom

- All teaching will be arranged remotely during the spring semester 2021.
- In order to participate in language and communication distance learning, the student should have a device equipped with a microphone and a camera.

Survival Course for Exchange Students (KIFF0013)

- The aim of the course is to offer students basic knowledge of the Finnish language so that they can cope with situations linked with everyday life.
- The course concentrates on practical language use; grammar is discussed to a lesser extent.
- Material will be provided by the teacher.

NB!

The Survival Course is directed at those students who do not intend to continue with their Finnish studies. If you want to continue, you will have to choose Beginners' Course I first.

Survival Course for Exchange Students (KIFF0013)

- 24 h, 4 h/week, 2 ECTS credits, level A1

Teaching:

Thursdays	12.15-13.45

- Enrolment in Nettiopsu ([ends January 8 at 18.00!](#))
- Max. 30 students, by the order of enrolment.
- Attendance at the first lesson is required.

Beginners' Course I (KIFF0001)

- The aim of the course is to offer the students a basic knowledge of the Finnish language in order to help them cope with various everyday situations and to give them a solid start with the grammar.
- During the lessons, basic grammar will be taught and various tasks will be practised both in pairs and as group work.
- Pronunciation exercises, listening comprehension exercises, communication exercises and a small number of writing tasks will be included.
- Material: Gehring & Heinzmann: Suomen mestari 1.

- Students (max. 30/group) will be selected by the order of enrolment, but preference will be given to Master's Program students.
- Attendance at the first lesson is required.

Intensive Beginners' Course (KIFF0003)

- 60 h, 6 h/week, 5 ECTS, level A1

Wednesdays	8.30-10.00 and
Fridays	8.30-10.00

→ Starting January 18

- Enrolment in Nettiopsu has ended, contact the teacher by email jrenie@utu.fi
- Students (max. 20) will be admitted by the order of enrolment.
- Degree students have priority and exchange students will be admitted only if there are places available.
- Attendance at the first meeting is required.
