# Course registration

- Course registration is done in [Peppi](#) – Register for all of your courses!
- Courses on your Learning Agreement – **NOT** the same as course registration!
- Registration for **independent** study options: Check the course description in Peppi (is it done in Peppi or simply by sending an e-mail to the teacher?)
- Make sure to **attend the first lecture** of a course to secure your place.
- You can register to courses from different TSE departments and also from other faculties with some restrictions.
- NB! If you plan to take courses organised by other HEIs, first check with your home university, if this is ok.

# Exam registration

- Check [exam.utu.fi](http://exam.utu.fi) and [peppi.utu.fi](http://peppi.utu.fi) for the exam dates! If the dates aren't available, the teacher will give them at the start of the course
- Three attempts / course
- Exams mostly as e-Exams in [exam.utu.fi](http://exam.utu.fi) > Book any time during the exam period
- Rare: "classic lecture hall exams" > Register 7 days before the examination in Peppi
- Results in Peppi in three weeks' time



# Exams & evaluation

- Electronic exams most common type of examination
  - Completed via E-exam
  - Video and audio surveillance!
  - Take **nothing** into the exam room with you!

- Course evaluation also with final papers and essays
- Occasional lecture room exams (nowadays seldom) and Moodle exams
- **Your teacher will instruct you about your course evaluation!**
- Be on time! No talking or copying! No phones allowed! **All cheating attempts are reported and lead to termination of your exchange.** Teachers apply software to find and verify plagiarism!

# What if...

...I do not want to take a course I have registered for?

Let the teacher know! It's okay if the course is still in your Peppi enrollments.

... I want to take a course I have not registered for or the course is full?

Contact the teacher!

... the courses I have selected are held at the same time?

Maybe it is possible to do them both? Ask the teachers if you need to be present on all lectures.

# What if...

... the course I want is not in Peppi?

Check the Study Guide! In which period is the course organised? Is it a self-study course?

...I don't have enough courses? / I can't register to all the courses I want?

Could you take more self-study courses?

Could you take more courses in later periods?

Could you do studies of your home university?

If you are interested in some special field, contact the department/teachers of that field!

Consider taking courses from different faculties!
