- In Finland student associations play a huge part in the life of students and student life highly revolves around activities that student associations organise.
- Their main purpose is to represent students' interests within their universities, streamline collaboration between university staff and students and of course taking care of their students, making sure everyone's time as a student will be unforgettable.
- This is most clearly seen in events organized by student associations, which often focuses on well-being, trying new activities, or simply hosting unforgettable parties!

- Student association of Turku School of Economics, that was founded in 1950! We have over 2000 student members!

- *We also organise some of the largest events in Turku and also the largest student event in Finland called Pikkulaskiainen with over 15 000 attendants.*
- *We also have our own club house (Parkki), where we organize events. It's just 200 meters from TSE.*

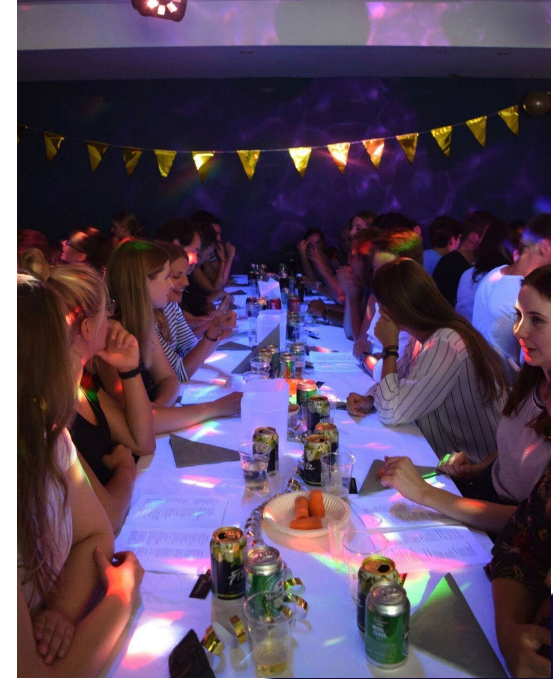

# Good to know dates

- **Pikkulaskiainen**, the largest student event in Finland is held on 26th of February in Turku!
- Ticket sale for **Pikkulaskiainen** that's only for TSE students (including all of you) is held on 27th of January. There's also ticket sale that's open for everyone and that will be held on 15th of January.
- **Poikkarit** (interdisciplinary overall party) is held on first Wednesday of every month. First one is held on 14th of January and ticket sale is currently live.
- Our **May Day season**, the highlight of academic year will start on 18th of April and last until 1st of May.

- We are responsible for representing our international students interests to university.
