

About the study programme

- The EdLearn programme aims to train experts in the areas of research on learning and sociology of education
- Throughout the studies, a strong emphasis is placed on students' research skills.
- The Master's thesis is considered an important opportunity for specialisation in the Programme.
- The Finnish-German Master Programme in Education is a double degree option that leads to the obtaining of two different degrees (UTU and Univ. Regensburg)
- This master's degree programme *does not* provide the students with formal teaching qualification.

MDP EdLearn's degree structure, Single degree option


- Orientation and General Studies 24 ECTS credits

Master's Thesis

- You don't need to have a research topic in mind before you apply. Generally topic ideas are developed along the way.
- You don't need to approach a potential supervisor beforehand. There will be a responsible supervisor from the department.
- The thesis process involves seminars where students share their ideas, interests and progress.
- You can choose your thesis topic, it is not assigned to you.
- Usually students work independently but it is an option to work in an existing research group.



Study time

- 2 academic years
- Academic year runs from 1 August until 31 July
- Semester dates:
- Autumn semester: 1 August -31 December
- Spring semester: 1 January 31 July
- Teaching is organised between 1 September and mid-December in autumn and between 7 January and mid-May during the spring semester.
- During summer students can take book exams, work on the Thesis, do an internship, return home or stay in Turku.



DEMARCATION OF STUDY TIME

- The targeted completion time for a Master's degree is two academic years
- Possibility to register as nonattending if studies are interrupted
- Students must submit the thesis and course assignments in time in order to get enough credits and to graduate in time

Time to apply!

- The application is open from 5th to 19th of January 2022
- Fill the electronic application at studyinfo.fi.

General admission criteria:

- you have a nationally recognized first cycle degree – typically a Bachelor's degree – from an accredited institution of higher education
- your degree corresponds to at least 180 ECTS (European credits) or to three years of full-time study
- your degree gives eligibility to master level studies in the country where it was issued
- You have excellent English language skills and a certificate that proves those skills.



Programme specific eligibility

- Persons who have completed a Bachelor's degree in education, adult education or special education are eligible to apply to the programme.
- Also applicants who have a Bachelor's degree from other fields of study, and who have either an official teacher's qualification, or who can prove a clear affinity to educational sciences, are eligible to apply to the programme.



Student selection

 The decision for admission will be based on the evaluation of:

- the field of applicant's previous degree(s)
- the amount, relevance and grades of the courses in the degree(s)
- motivation letter



Tuition fees and scholarhips

- Scholarships are available for student subject to tuition fees
- The scholarships are awarded based on academic merits.
- Applying for a scholarship is simple: just indicate "yes" to the appropriate question on your online application form for the programme.
- All applicants who have applied for the scholarships will receive information of the decisions in their admission offer.



Enrollment

- In order to enroll in the programme you must first confirm your study place at studyinfo.fi.
- Please note that you can accept only one study place leading to a higher education degree in Finland per semester. The choice you make is binding.
- Also notice that if you do not accept the study place within the deadline you forfeit your right to enroll in the programme.
