Selecting Courses	Exchange students can combine courses from different faculties with some limitations provided they have previous knowledge in the subject area. Students can work on their theses or participate in research projects in Turku, but 50 % of the workload (excluding PhD students) must be courses and the student must find the supervisor by him-/herself. Studies at the Faculties of <b>Medicine</b> and <b>Turku School of Economics</b> are not available for students who are not majoring in these subjects. Faculties of <b>Law</b> and <b>Education</b> can accept students from other faculties only if there are available places on courses.
