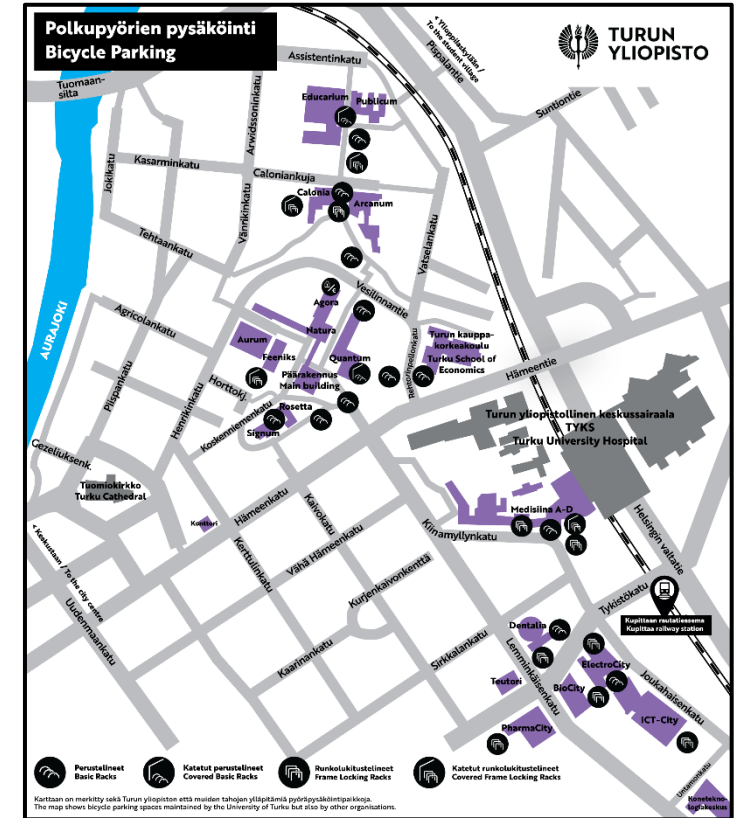

Bicycles

- Covered bike parking areas at Aurum and Professorinkuja (2021/2022)
- Agora bicycle garage with frame locking racks for staff use (2022)
- Bicycle pumps available to borrow at campus info desks (2022)
- Designing and implementing painted street surface signs guiding to bicycle parking areas on Turku campus (2024)



- A map listing bicycle parking facilities on the campus to the intranet and public website (2023)
- Adding more covered and uncovered frame locking racks to Turku and Rauma campuses (2024)
- Enhanced winter maintenance for certain bike parking areas (2025 onwards)

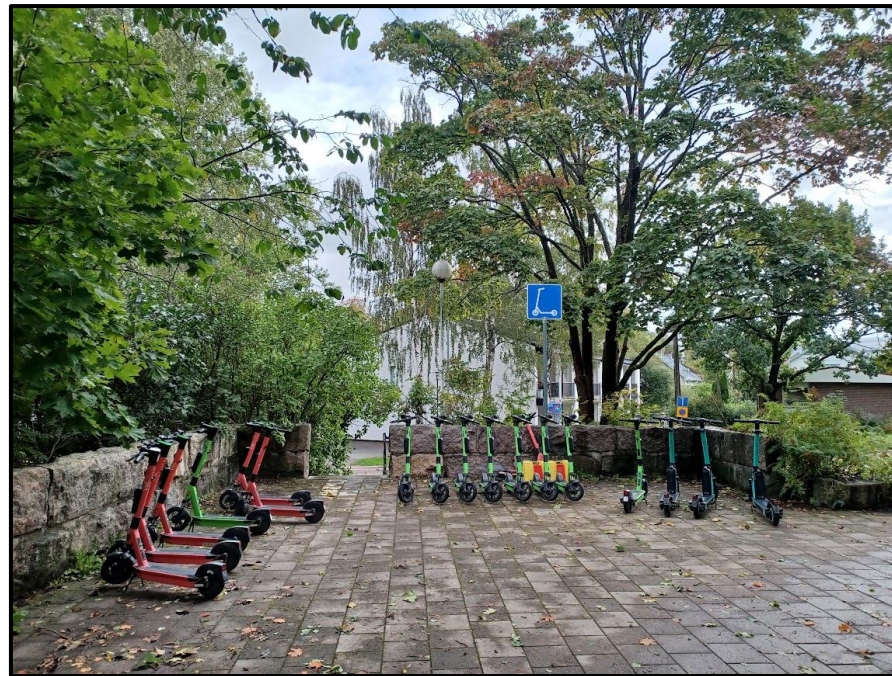


- **Actions taken by the City of Turku:** transforming nearby routes to be bicycle-friendly (Rehtorinpellonkatu bicycle street in 2023 and Inspehtorinkatu village road in 2024); Rehtorinpellonkatu bicycle parking and bike maintenance / wash station (2024); adding city bike stations near the campus

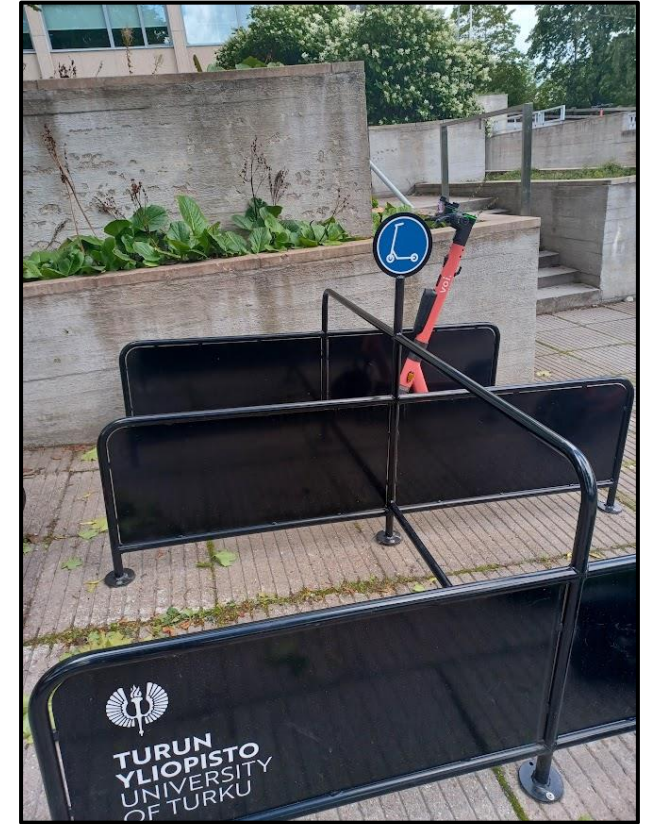


Electric kick scooters

- Innovating a solution for e-scooter parking: establishing designated parking and no-parking zones into the operator apps with GPS boundaries and installing traffic signs and street surface paintings indicating parking areas on Turku and Rauma campuses (2022)



- Campus e-scooter parking areas and no-parking zones added to the City of Turku's [Service Map](#) (2022)
- University's own e-scooter parking rack (2022)
- Painting of e-scooter parking spaces on Turku campus (2024 onwards)
- **Actions taken by the City of Turku:**
collaboration with the operators, installment of e-scooter racks and parking spaces near the campus



Cars



- Day parking as an alternative to monthly permits (2022): staff members who drive to work less frequently can purchase a daily parking permit [€2.50/day]
- Mapping of accessible parking spaces on Turku and Rauma campuses for the Automobile and Touring Club of Finland's mobile app (2022)
- Electric vehicle charging stations available for staff use in Agora's upper garage (2022)
- Merging staff parking zones on Turku campus (2023): parking is now allowed across the entire campus with the same permit
- Adding electric vehicle charging stations on Turku and Rauma campuses (2024)

Other

- Strengthening mobility and outdoor area related communication through intranet and newsletters (2021 onwards)
- Adding area signs to Turku campus (2023)
- Utilizing the Tuudo app to reach, for example, new students (2023 onwards)
- Mapping locker rooms with showers: staff members can request access to the locker room nearest to their workstation (2024)



- Survey on commuting conditions for staff (2024)
- Updated Turku campus map (2024)
- Outdoor furniture, such as table sets and benches, to Turku campus (2024)
- Outdoor gym to Turku campus (2024)
- Updated Rauma campus map (2025)
- Survey on commuting conditions for students (2025)

- Rebuilding intranet's Parking page to better suit all commuting methods (2025/2026)
- Adding safer bicycle parking alternatives (2026)
- Föli schedules (local public transport) on lobby displays
