## ► Introduction from Director

Following two years of life dominated by the Covid 19 pandemic, 2022 was the year in which life in TIAS returned to (the new) “normal”. Our Fellows were able to do more of the things which academics cherish such as attending conferences (in person!) and presenting papers, undertaking field work and meeting face to face with colleagues. We have much to be grateful here as academic life got back on track and some routines returned. We remained wary, but extremely grateful.

I would once again like to thank our Coordinator, Jenni Kankaanpää, for going well beyond the call of duty in her work for TIAS and ensuring that we ran smoothly and efficiently. The TIAS Board, and especially its chair, Jaakko Suominen, continued to offer great support and thanks are due to them. Our Visiting Professor in Mentoring, Ulrika Maude, again supported our Fellows and the wider university community in myriad ways. My thanks to her. Senior Research Fellow Georges Kazan continued to work on research bids and the development of strategy and many thanks are due to him for his dedication and hard work.

Of course, 2022 was also the year of the war in Ukraine which affected us all. Within TIAS, thanks to the support of the Kone Foundation, we were able to offer places to displaced scholars as part of our commitment to the Scholars at Risk (SAR) programme which we were in the privileged position of being able to undertake. More details of this work can be found on page 56.

A highly significant development for TIAS was the award in July of €1.14M from the Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions COFUND scheme for the development of a new Fellowship path, the Turku Intersectoral Excellence Scheme (TIES – [utu.fi/ties](http://utu.fi/ties)). This exciting new programme will involve recruited Fellows undertaking secondments outside of higher education for up to six months. Our idea was to merge the traditional “bottom-up” approach of Institutes for Advanced Studies with a commitment to working with external partners and we are excited at the prospect of working more closely with partners within and beyond Turku in the coming years. Georges Kazan wrote an excellent bid and we were delighted to receive this funding, which will make a significant contribution to our activities in future years.

TIAS also took part in the **University’s Research Assessment Exercise (RAE)**, which is an internal periodic review of research activities. The Review focused

on reviewing our research activities between 2014 and 2019, while also looking forward to potential future development. It consisted of the compilation of a list of activities, the submission of a written report and an external review by an international panel. The latter process included the Panel meeting not only with the Director, but also with current and former Fellows at both Postdoctoral and Collegium level. This was the first time that TIAS had been part of the RAE and we very much benefitted from the opportunity to reflect upon what we have been doing and what we might do to develop further. While the final report is confidential to the University, it can be noted that it is one which both complimented our previous work and gave us some important pointers towards future development. In short, it is a very useful document and here I would particularly like to thank the external review team, led by Jo Shaw of the University of Edinburgh, for their report. We look forward to implementing their recommendations.

We continued our series of workshops entitled "**Beyond Advanced Studies**" funded by the Joint Committee for Nordic research councils in the Humanities and Social Sciences (NOS-HS). Further details of this series and the development of a new network of Nordic IASs can be found in the International Activities section on page 55 below.

One important internal change was that in order to align TIAS activities more towards the pace of the academic year, we moved the start of TIAS Fellowships from January to September. The first of these Fellows began in September 2022 and this Report includes only their contributions since their arrival.

While an Annual Report inevitably means looking back there is also much to look forward to. In 2023 TIAS celebrates our fifteenth anniversary and we are planning an event to mark that. We will also continue our public engagement via the dedicated series of lectures in Turku's main library and will seek to develop more external engagement, especially in the context of the anticipated arrival of the new TIES Fellows.

We welcome the opportunity to collaborate with colleagues from within and beyond the University and continue to look forward to hearing from you.

## ► TIAS Mission and profile

Founded in 2008, Turku Institute for Advanced Studies (TIAS) works across the faculties of Economics, Education, Humanities, Law and Social Science within the University of Turku to foster internationally excellent interdisciplinary research. TIAS is a joint enterprise between the faculties of Education; Humanities, Law, and Social Sciences and the Turku School of Economics.

TIAS funds its Fellows to undertake three-year research projects. The Fellows represent two different career stages: postdoctoral and mid-career (collegium). Postdoctoral Fellows are able to advance their professional competence after recently being awarded their doctorates. Collegium Fellows have the opportunity to develop the competence required for more demanding research posts or other expert positions after the postdoctoral period. In addition to their salary, TIAS Fellows receive €3,400 per annum towards their research costs.

TIAS Fellows are selected via an international competition. A Call for applicants was open from November 2021 to January 2022, with four positions in each category. A Call for applicants to the TIES programme was open from November 2022 to January 2023,

In 2022 the TIAS research community consisted at various points of a total 35 Fellows: 17 Collegium and 18 Postdoctoral. In addition to Fellows, TIAS staff in 2022 comprised of the Director: Professor Martin Cloonan; Co-ordinator: Dr Jenni Kankaanpää, Controller: Markus Piippo; Senior Research Fellow: Georges Kazan and Visiting Professor in Mentoring: Ulrika Maude.

The Institute holds regular meetings for its Fellows, providing the opportunity for them to interact with one another and present their work in a collegial and interdisciplinary environment. In 2022 Fellows presented on a diverse range of topics including sustainability of Finnish companies, European constitutionalism and children in social movements.

In addition to supporting its Fellows in their projects via the provision of research allowances and continuing professional development activities, TIAS also hosts a range of events designed to appeal across disciplinary boundaries. In 2022 this included seminars on Developing an International Profile and Values in Higher Education. In addition, we held online seminars which introduced our new Fellows to the wider world. In August we held another grant writing workshop where grants in progress were subjected to peer review.

We welcome enquiries about the co-hosting of events which are likely to appeal to audiences drawn from across our constituent faculties.

## ► International Activity

TIAS continues to be an active member of the University-based Institutes for Advanced Study (UBIAS) organisation and will attend its Directors' meeting in Nagoya in 2023.

We also continue to attract international visitors and applicants for TIAS positions. The new TIES programme is expected to result in the number of international TIAS Fellows increasing. In addition, we continue to support and facilitate international visits by our Fellows.

The most important development in the international arena has been that TIAS is leading the development of network of **Nordic Institutes for Advanced Study**, known as NordIAS. The formation of this network is a direct outcome of the **Beyond Advanced Studies workshops** which were led by TIAS and funded with a grant from the Joint Committee for Nordic Research Councils in the Humanities and Social Sciences (NOS-HS). The workshops were held between November 2021 and May 2022 and, amongst many other things, saw attendance by all the Directors of Institutes for Advanced Studies (IAS) in the Nordic region. Discussions at the workshops led to a commitment to consider ways for the Nordic IASs to work together. In 2023 the members of NordIAS will sign an agree Memorandum of Understanding and meet together again in Aarhus in June. This exciting development would never have happened without the dedicated work of Georges Kazan who was responsible for the vision and funding of the Beyond Advanced Studies workshops. The Nordic IASs have much to thank him for.

We were pleased to welcome Professor Simon Frith (University of Edinburgh) and Professor Tristram Hooley (Inland Norway University of Applied Sciences and University of Derby) as Visiting Scholars. Professor Helmi Järviiluoma-Mäkelä (University of Eastern Finland) was also a distinguished visitor.

Scholars at Risk (SAR, [www.scholarsatrisk.org](http://www.scholarsatrisk.org)) is an international network which seeks to support scholars facing repression in their home countries and to support academic freedom. Since 2018 TIAS has been leading SAR activities within the University of Turku. Work in 2022 included receiving further funding to from the Kone Foundation to support the development of work focused on the crisis in Ukraine. TIAS will seek to develop more SAR activities in 2023, focusing on developing those SAR scholars whom we are fortunate enough to be able to host.
