

Tuition fees

Tuition fees range from 2000€ to 12 000€ for one academic year.

The fee is based on the time you study at the University of Turku.

 If it takes you 3 years to graduate you will pay for 3 years. Or if you graduate in 1,5 years you pay for 1,5 years.

Tuition fees will not be charged from citizens of EU/EEA/Switzerland.

 Also students with permanent residence in Finland will not pay tuition.

Tuition Fees

Tuition fee for one year can be paid in one or two instalments.

Full academic year or autumn and spring semesters separately.


First year tuition fee (or first instalment) must be paid by the end of July.

Tuition fee paid via

- <u>UTUShop</u> University online shop with credit card.
- Or with invoice if credit card payment is not possible.

Students may not register and start studies before they have paid the fee.

Students pay for the full duration of their studies.

Scholarships

University of Turku offers generous scholarships to the best students who pay tuition fees.

We have two scholarship programmes offered to international students.

University of Turku Scholarship

Covers 100% or 50% of the tuition fee.

Finland Scholarship

- A new scholarship available in 2022.
- Covers the tuition fee and includes a 5 000 € grant for Master students.

University of Turku Scholarships

Up to 30% of those who pay tuition fees can get a scholarship.

- Scholarship that covers the tuition fee.
- Scholarship that covers 50 % of the tuition fee.

The scholarships are awarded for the first year and conditionally for the next 1 or 2 years.

- Studies must progress as planned.
- 55 credits during the first year.

Scholarship for outstanding performance during the 1st study year. The scholarship covers the rest of the programme duration. Can be applied by students who pay for their first year of studies. Will be awarded if:

 Studies progress as planned with an average grade of 3 (scale 1-5) or higher and the student receives at least 55 credits during the first year.





Finland Scholarship

Finland Scholarships are a part of the national Finland Scholarship programme.

- Funded by the Finnish Ministry of Education and Culture.
- The Finland Scholarships will be available until 2024.

For the best non-EU/EEA applicants who are admitted to Master's degree studies at the University of Turku.

1-3 Finland Scholarships in each programme.

The Finland Scholarship covers the tuition fee and includes a 5,000 € grant.

Applying for and Awarding of Scholarships

You apply for the scholarships at the same time you apply to our programmes.

 Just indicate "yes" in the appropriate questions on your application form for the programme.

Scholarship decisions will be published together with the admission offer (end of March).

 You may be put on the waiting list and will be informed of a possible scholarship at the latest by the end of May.



Awarding of Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded based on academic merit only.

Extracurricular activities are not evaluated and means testing is not used.

Applicants are ranked based on the admission criteria.

 This may include an interview, motivation letter or relevant academic experience in addition to the grades of the previous degree.

Scholarships

- The University of Turku offers smaller grants to registered students for research or travel purposes.
- None of the scholarships are based on nationality.
- We encourage all students to look for scholarships from their own country as well as international foundations.

Residence permit (Visa)

- In order to come to Finland you will need to have proven funds to support yourself, 6720€ for one year.
- Make sure you apply right after you receive an admission offer!
