



University of Turku Student Scholarships and Grant Funds in 2026

1. University of Turku Student Scholarship Fund

For distinguished students enrolled at the University of Turku (15 250 €)

Faculties distribute the following sums in one or more scholarships:

Faculty of Science	1 710 €
Faculty of Law	910 €

2. University of Turku Joint Student Scholarship Fund

The sums that each fund admit are listed below in brackets. Each sum may be distributed as one or more scholarships.

All Faculties

- rewarding scientific research in the field of shipping or shipbuilding (250 €)
- primarily student from Kuopio, secondarily student from Pohjois-Savo (450 €)
- student born or raised in Rauma (125 €)
- student with a degree from a school in the city of Joensuu (school certificate as an appendix) (250 €)
- research related to Turku in the field of history, (political) economics or natural sciences (appendix: Research plan or abstract that clarifies the topic. The work may be incomplete) (5 100 €)
- present or past student at the University of Turku with a thesis and research in the field of history or seeking funding for completing a worthy research program in the field of history (400 €)
- students from Satakunta and/or Varsinais-Suomi (8 700 €)

Faculty of Humanities

- student at the Faculty of Humanities or the Faculty of Science (250 €)*
- student who majors in general history and who is distinguished and advanced in their studies (20 125 €)
- students aiming for the degree of Master of Art (200 €)*
- student at the Faculty of Humanities or the Faculty of Science primarily from Pöytyä (400 €)*

* This scholarship is shared between different faculties



- degree or postgraduate student of archaeology or research project on archaeology (925 €)
- travel scholarship or reward for students of German Philology (125 €)

Faculty of Education

- advanced student at the Rauma Department of Teacher Education (12 675 €)

Faculty of Medicine

- students at the Faculty of Medicine (1 175 €)
- students aiming for the degree of Master of Art (200 €)*
- student of medicine or natural sciences (125 €)*

Faculty of Science

- student at the Faculty of Humanities or the Faculty of Science (250 €)*
- student of mathematics, physics or chemistry (925 €)
- students aiming for the degree of Master of Art (200 €)*
- student at the Faculty of Humanities or the Faculty of Science primarily from Pöytyä (400 €)*
- student of medicine or natural sciences (125 €)*

Faculty of Law

Faculty of Law does not have specific scholarships in this fund. Students can apply for the scholarships that are meant for all students.

Faculty of Technology

- student of biochemistry and food chemistry (3 975 €)
- students aiming for the degree of Master of Art (200 €)*
- student of medicine or natural sciences (125 €)*

Turku School of Economics

- student of economics from Satakunta (400 €)
- student with a pro gradu thesis on economics or student conducting research in the field of economics (450 €)
- student conducting research on economics (250 €)
- student of economics or scientific research on economics (Fund of banker Mauno Mäki) (450 €)
- student of economics with priority given to students of economic geography (250 €)
- student of economics or research on economics (Fund of commercial councillor K. Toivonen) (525 €)



- student of economics from Varsinais-Suomi (450 €)
- students or researchers in the field of corporate planning and development projects for a maximum of one (1) year for research projects related to research activities at the Turku School of Economics (1 625 €)
- students aiming for the degree of Master of Art (200 €)*

Faculty of Social Sciences

- students aiming for the degree of Master of Art (200 €)*

In addition, scholarships and grants are distributed primarily for supporting the education of children and young people from the Johnsson family, no matter what their current field of study is (distributed by the family trust, 1 950 €)

3. University of Turku Research Grant Fund

The fund distributes grants in one or more parts for researchers or doctoral researchers conducting scientific research at the university or involved in university research projects.

In 2026 the grants delivered from the fund are worth 45 350 € and they can be applied by researchers and doctoral researchers at the following faculties: **Faculty of Science (12 110 €), Faculty of Law (3 630 €), Faculty of Technology (12 150 €), Turku School of Economics (7 480 €) and Faculty of Social Sciences (9 980 €)**. The faculties switch annually.

In addition, one scholarship without application process is granted by Turun Suomalainen Yliopistoseura (3 650 €).

4. University of Turku Joint Research Grant Fund

The sums that each fund admit are listed below in brackets. Each sum may be distributed as one or more scholarships.

All Faculties

- postgraduate student from within the reach of Säästöpankki's area of operation who will continue their studies at the University of Turku after graduating (3 800 €)
- Doctor of Philosophy or Master of Arts aiming to become a Finnish scientist (350 €)

Faculty of Humanities

- preparing a doctoral thesis on Finnish history (3 100 €)
- student at the Faculty of Humanities preparing a doctoral thesis on general history 4 800 €)
- Bachelor of Arts or Licentiate of Philosophy studying Finnish linguistics who has proven distinguished in the field and who has presented a worthy research plan (1 050 €)



Faculty of Education

Faculty of Education does not have specific scholarships in this fund. Doctoral researchers and other researchers can apply for the scholarships that are meant for all researchers/doctoral researchers.

Faculty of Medicine

- supporting research or professional development in the field of dentistry, primarily periodontology (20 650 €)
- medical research (108 700 €)

Faculty of Science

- in the field of chemistry persons conducting research, researchers preparing a doctoral thesis or researchers with a dissertation or research groups lead by them to promote the research (66 050 €)

Faculty of Law

- research and education in the field of law (16 500 €)
- student with the grade laudatur in a thesis from the field of civil or commercial law including water rights legislation and with the potential of extending their work into preparing a doctoral thesis and working as scientists (9 650 €)
- student with the grade laudatur in their pro gradu thesis on criminal, procedural, administrative, financial, constitutional or international law (9 950 €)
- doctoral researcher at the Faculty of Law (6 200 €)

Faculty of Technology

Faculty of Technology does not have specific scholarships in this fund. Doctoral researchers and other researchers can apply for the scholarships that are meant for all researchers/doctoral researchers.

Turku School of Economics

- one or more students with a pro gradu thesis on (political) economics or in a related field of science (2 100 €)

Faculty of Social Sciences

Faculty of Social Sciences does not have specific scholarships in this fund. Doctoral researchers and other researchers can apply for the scholarships that are meant for all researchers/doctoral researchers.
