
Programme structure and mobility scheme

Two semesters abroad are required and students may not spend more than 2 semesters at the same university.

Admission requirements

- a. Candidates must hold a Bachelor's Degree (or recognised equivalent) in one of the following areas: Modern Languages, Philology, Culture, History, International Relations, and other Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH);
- b. Candidates must know at least two languages at C1 level (according to the Common European Framework) among the following: Finnish, French, German, Italian, Portuguese, Romanian, Spanish, besides English as a lingua franca.
