Local Register Office

- maintains Finnish population register
- registers foreigners (Finnish ID Code)
- gives person a home municipality (relevant for Degree students)

Purpose of an ID Code

- registering a person in the Population Information System
- university database
- opening a bank account

- **NB! Obtaining an ID Code is obligatory to all students.**

Local Register Office

- POP UP on campus at the Student Centre Disco on **4 - 5 September at 10.00 – 12.00 and 13.00 – 15.00**
 - No appointment needed, the easiest way
 - 4 Sep: students A-K (according to your last name)
 - 5 Sep: students L-Z (according to your last name)
 - Students will be informed when codes available for pick-up at Disco
- If you miss these dates – what to do?
 1. Visit the Local Register Office
 2. Send your Finnish ID (copy of the paper you get from the Office) using UTU mail to disco@utu.fi

Registration process for students

- Take with you
 1. passport / ID card
 2. residence permit card (non-EU students)
 3. registration certificate
 4. your lease (your Finnish address)
- For non-EU/EEA citizens:
If you got the ID code with the residence permit **you have to do all this anyway.**
